Dear Friends,

Our Jewish Community Foundation of Greater Mercer is dedicated to cultivating philanthropy for the benefit of the Jewish and broader communities. We serve as a trusted resource – helping families deepen their charitable giving impact, building financial security for beloved Jewish institutions, and providing meaningful enrichment programs.

Highlights from this year include:

- We administered more than 600 grants to nonprofits, totaling \$1.4 million, of which 68% supported local charities.
- We hosted community webinars and welcomed esteemed presenters including Adina Langer, Ben Dworkin, and Leah Boustan.
- The Foundation co-sponsored Jewish Voices of Princeton, an oral history project preserving the contributions of Jews in Princeton.
- We presented the college book awards and scholarships for study in Israel and, in partnership with the Federation, administered the Mitzvah Match program – a giving and learning opportunity for graduating high school seniors.
- We celebrated our Life & Legacy partners, some of which have participated in this program, dedicated to sustaining our local Jewish heritage, for a decade.


